

What is Centre Support?

Weekly activities

- Includes daily 5-10 minute A&R activities explaining what educators and staff must know, practice and understand to achieve meeting and exceeding

- Contains targeted information and tips for Nominated Supervisor
- Comes with partially completed QIP template based on week's activities and reflections
- Includes completed QIP example showing how to write QIP to achieve Exceeding
- Includes checklist to monitor practices against NQS
- Includes structured review of one or two policies
- Includes information sheet to display so families know focus of weekly activities, QIP and Policy under review (QA 6)
- Contains tips to ensure educators have skills to manage children's behaviour
- Provides clear examples of how to document children's learning
- Includes activities to foster teamwork
