Cleaning General		
Do you clean the Service throughout the day eg spills immediately cleaned,		
benches and tables wiped down?		
Do you adhere to cleaning schedules at all times?		
Do you use detergent and water to clean the service, then rinse and dry?		
Do you use fresh detergent and water every day?		
Do you clean using buckets or squirt bottles rather than spray bottles where possible?		
If using spray bottles (eg for disinfectant) do you spray into a cloth then		
wipe rather than spraying directly onto dirty surface		
Do you disinfect after detergent and water if surfaces have been (or may		
have been) contaminated with hazardous material (eg poo, urine, saliva,		
vomit or blood)?		
Do you use disposable gloves to clean poo, urine, saliva, vomit or blood?		
Do you include regularly clean ceiling fans, ventilation grills, light fittings?		
Cleaning Specific Facilities/Equipment		
Do you clean sandpits as soon as they're contaminated by animal or human		
poo, blood or other body fluids (refer Sand Pit policy)?		
Do you clean soiled cots by removing most of the soiling/spill with paper		
towels, placing soiled linen in a plastic lined, lidded laundry bin and cleaning		
soiled mattress with detergent and water?		
Do you carry soiled linen away from your body?		
Do you soak soiled linen to remove most of contamination, wash separately		
in hot water and detergent and dry in the sun (preferable) or on hot cycle in		
dryer?		
Do you wash your clothing or aprons daily with detergent and hot water?		
Do you vacuum carpets and mats daily?
