Do you use two nappy change surfaces during the day eg a waterproof sheet over the change mat is removed at lunch time					
Do you make sure nappy creams and cleaning products are inaccessible to children?					
Supervision					
Do you supervise children AT ALL TIMES on the change table?					
Change procedures					
Do you make sure paper towel is on table, wipes and bag for dirty nappy close and ready?					
Do you wear gloves to change nappies?					
Do you help older children up the steps to the change table?					
Do you remove excess poo and flush down toilet?					
Do you clean children's bottoms wiping from front to back and dry with wipes?					
Do you seal soiled nappies, paper towels, wipes and gloves in plastic bag and place in a hands free lined, lidded bin for removal at end of nappy change?					
Do you make sure nappy bins inaccessible to children?					
Do you seal soiled clothing (and cloth nappy if relevant) in a bag for washing?					
Do you tell parents if child has soiled clothing?					
Do you remove the paper on the change table before dressing child in clean clothes?					
Do you remove gloves before touching clean clothing or clean nappy?					
Do you wash your hands three times during the nappy change procedure: before starting, after changing the nappy, after cleaning the change table?					
Do you wash infants' hands with pre-moistened disposable wipes and dry them?					
Cleaning Procedures					
Do you clean the change table with detergent and warm water after each nappy change?					
Do you rinse and dry the change table (eg with paper towel) after washing?					



Do you disinfect the change table if there are spills of blood, urine, poo or vomit which are known/suspected to be infectious?					
Do you make sure cleaning products are inaccessible to children?
