Questions	Response	Pass or Fail
Miss Roxi asks if educators need to be able to show/give families information about the EYLF/MTOP? Do they?	Yes. Reg 75 says they need to show families information about the contents and operation of the educational program – which is defined in the National Law as a program based on an approved learning framework ie EYLF/MTOP.	
Mr Reyne asks exactly what information educators need to show families about their child's learning. What's your response?	Reg 76 says parents must be given information about their child's participation in the program and how the program relates to their child ie how their child is progressing towards the learning outcomes.	
Miss Loretta asks whether sharing information verbally with families counts towards the Reg requirements. Does it?	Yes. The NQF Guide for this element discusses sharing information through conversations, phone calls and meetings as well as through documented evidence which must be kept in line with Reg 74 and 76.
