
Regulation 148 Staff and educator records -centre-based services (Educational leader)

Fair Work

The Federal Government's Fair Work website <u>https://www.fairwork.gov.au/</u> has a lot of simple, easy to understand information about employee entitlements as well as some useful templates. Each week we'll share information from the website. This week we're highlighting the <u>new paid family and domestic</u> <u>violence leave</u>.

On 27 October 2022, the Australian Government amended the Fair Work Act to give all employees an entitlement to paid family and domestic violence leave.

The changes mean that from next year, all employees will be able to access 10 days of paid family and domestic violence leave in a 12-month period.
